Zealous for Good Works

Why Work?

- Don't work for yourself greed
- Don't work to get other's stuff envy
- Work for <u>GOD</u> Colossians 3:23-24

Give God <u>100%</u> of your heart.

Let God have say over 100% of your life.

Work like you are working for God <u>85%</u> of the time!

rest every 7th day

Rest is <u>Commanded</u> - Work is <u>Expected</u>

Feel Zeal! Passion!

Zeal is <u>Ideal</u> - Discipline is <u>Daily</u>



Review the sermon, what were the key points? Consider **Titus 3:14** What questions did it raise for you? What felt most important to you?

When have you felt the most zeal in your life? What is the difference between "manufactured" zeal, and passion and zeal that come out naturally?

Think more about apathy in our society. What do you think causes it? In what ways is it spiritual in nature? How is it overcome in our lives? Consider **Romans 12:9-13**

While there is apathy in our society, there is also a great deal of busyness and many people who work at an ungodly level. Do you find it hard to rest? Why or why not?

Why do you think we often feel more guilty for overworking than under-resting? What does rest mean to you?

Jesus got in trouble for working on the Sabbath. One of his responses is found in **Mark 2:27-26**, another in **Matt. 12:1-12**. How does this integrate with the idea of not resting being sin? What is a godly balance on the narrow way?
